



Lightroom Renaming & Resizing Images

In Lightroom images are resized in export. In the Library Module, Click Export and this is the screen that displays:

In the Export Location panel, Select where you want to export the image, I usually select Desktop.

Drop down to the File Settings panel and set the Image format to Jpeg, set the Color Space to sRGB for projected images, (Use ProPhoto for Printing) and the quality to 100 %.

In the Image sizing Panel, check the resize to Fit box and select Longest Edge. Set the box below to 1024 Pixels and the resolution to 72 PPI. Click Export and the resized image will be sent to our desktop or where you set the "export to" location.

One more point, in the File Naming Panel you can name the file to comply with the naming convention, i.e. if this is the themed photo change the file name to 'Advanced_Ed_Robidoux_Flower', if it's your Open image theme would look like 'Open_Ed_Robidoux_Boat'
